Dear parent / guardian

We have become increasingly concerned about some parents / families who are not adhering to guidance around COVID-19.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:

1. Families need to adhere to the local lockdown rules. The restrictions state:

‘You must not meet people you don’t live with in each other’s home or garden.’

Unfortunately, we have an increasing number of families that are mixing households in their own homes. This puts ALL pupils, staff and families at much greater risk. We need people to work together to protect the whole school and community by taking these restrictions seriously.

We have been asked to make West Midlands Police aware of any breaches of these restrictions that we know of.

2. If you feel a member of the household may have coronavirus you should book a test immediately. All members of the household should isolate until you receive the results of your test.

When a household or person within a household is isolating. This means:

- do not go to work, school or public places do not go on public transport or use taxis
- do not go out to get food and medicine
- do not have visitors in your home, including friends and family
- do not go out to exercise
