Reception Farm Visit – Mount Pleasant Children’s Farm

We are planning to take all Reception pupils on a trip to Mount Pleasant Children’s farm in May. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to visit a working farm; and one designed specifically to cater for children, and taking their health and safety into account.



Class RN will go to the farm on Monday, 13th May 2019

Class RAL will go to the farm on Tuesday, 14th May 2019

Class RD will go to the farm on Wednesday 15th May 2019

Class RB will go to the farm on Thursday, 16th May 2019

Pupils will leave school at 9.00 a.m. and will be returning in time for the end of the school day. However these timings are approximate and dependent upon traffic. It will not be necessary to send your child with any spending money as a very busy programme of events has been organized. Pupils will require a packed lunch, which can be provided by school. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch, please indicate this on the consent form.

Children will need to wear jeans or trousers, sensible shoes and a warm jacket. The farm will provide wellington boots and a waterproof jacket for the children to wear. Please complete the section below specifying your child’s shoe size.

The cost of the trip for the year group is as follows; £820 for the coach travel to the venue and an admission price of £882. The cost of the coach will be covered by school but we would request a parental contribution towards the cost of admission to the farm of £7.35 per pupil. **By law, schools may only ask for a contribution towards an educational visit to help with the cost. However, if insufficient contributions for any planned trip are received, we will have no choice but to cancel the trip.** If this would be helpful a payment plan can be arranged by speaking to Mrs Sale in the office. Please return the consent form with your parental contribution of £7.35 by **Friday, 2nd May 2019**, if you would like your child to take part in this visit.
