Year 4 Visit to the Brighthouse Centre

We are planning to take all year 4 pupils to the Brighthouse Centre as part of our work on developing learning outside the classroom. The Brighthouse is a centre just outside Atherstone which has been purpose built for pupil visits.

Class 4M will go on Tuesday 21st April 2020
Class 4U will go on Wednesday 22nd April 2020
Class 4F will go on Thursday 23rd April 2020
Class 4J will be split across the three days

Pupils will be taking part in orienteering and team building activities, making natural art pictures in the woods and completing a sound map in the local fields. Children will need to wear jeans or trousers, sensible shoes and a waterproof jacket. Pupils will also need to bring a spare pair of shoes (wellies would be ideal) to wear outside as the woods and area surrounding the centre may be muddy.

Please bring your children into school at 8.50am on their trip day so we can have a prompt departure, we will be returning to school by 6pm. Due to the time that we will be returning, all pupils will need to be collected from school, (please wait in the playground outside the school office). The timings are approximate depending on traffic.

The cost of the trip for the year group is £720. The cost of the coach will be covered by the school but we would request a parental contribution towards the costs of £6.00 per pupil. If you would like your child to take part in this visit, please sign the consent form and return it to the school office with your parental contribution by Monday 30th March 2020. By law, schools may only ask for a contribution towards an educational visit to help with the cost. However, if insufficient contributions for any planned trip are received, we will have no choice but to cancel the trip. If this would be helpful a payment plan can be arranged by speaking to Mrs Sale in the office.

Pupils will require a packed lunch, ***if your child receives a free school lunch, they can be provided with a school packed lunch, please indicate your request for a packed lunch on the consent form.*** As we will be at the Brighthouse until the early evening a cooked meal will be provided for the pupils. They will have a choice of chicken or quorn nuggets, chips and baked beans. Please indicate their choice on the consent form.
