Year 6 Residential trip to Bell Heath

In recent years we have always offered our Y6 pupils a residential experience over 4 days. Recently, this has been at a centre run by Sandwell Authority with spaces for 40 pupils. This year, we would like to offer the residential experience to more pupils, so have booked a centre in Worcestershire called Bell Heath. This will hold 60 pupils, so offers the experience to half of our Y6 cohort.

In order to make this affordable for as many pupils as possible we have booked a 3 day / 2 night stay from Monday 10th June to Wednesday 12th June 2019. Pupils will leave school on Monday morning and return by the end of the school day on Wednesday. The cost of this visit is £126 per pupil, including the transport to and from the centre.



Bell Heath was formerly one of the centres run by Birmingham LA, but it has now been taken over by an independent organisation, who offer a wide variety of activities under the instruction of a qualified team. Activities such as archery, abseiling, climbing, bush craft, ropes courses, orienteering and grass sledging are just some of the activities which are available.

The centre is a purpose built one storey building with superb facilities for the children. There are fully trained centre staff, well equipped accommodation, lovely grounds and a wide choice of home cooked meals.

Payment for this trip can be made in instalments to spread the cost over a number of months. For those parents who prefer, we can offer a payment plan of as little as £5.00 per week. In the past, we have had many parents who prefer this option, so please pop and see Mrs Sale in the office if you would prefer to pay by this method.

Non-refundable deposit of £36 to secure your child's place by Friday 18th January 2019

£30 by Friday 1st February 2019

£30 by Friday 1st March 2019

£30 by Friday 5th April 2019

Places for the visit will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If all 60 places are filled, we will operate a waiting list in the order we receive the forms.
