English

In English we will continue to improve our reading skills through Letters and Sounds phonics sessions.

Maths

In Maths this half term we will focus on using a variety of strategies to add and subtract, consolidating on place value knowledge by recognising the value of numbers in 2/3 digit numbers



Science



In Science we will be identifying and naming a variety of common plants, including garden plants, wild plants and trees, and those classified as deciduous and evergreen.

We will also be identifying and describing the basic structure of a variety of common plants including roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers.
